

At **08:20** this morning a social-media account posted a **14-second video** which appears to show the director of a local organization accepting cash from a government official. It is spreading among local accounts. Your organization has to decide what to do, and the phone is already ringing.

1	The account. Created two days ago. No biography. Eleven posts. The profile picture also appears on several unrelated accounts.
2	The video. 14 seconds, heavily compressed. The face is visible for about four seconds. The audio says <i>"this is our agreement."</i> Lip movement is partly obscured. No file information came with the repost.
3	The room. It looks like a conference venue used by many organizations. A sign behind the speakers is partly visible: "...Rights Forum 2025."
4	Your own records. The director did attend a public forum at that venue in November 2025, and was filmed at an award ceremony there. Staff do not recognise the words in the clip.
5	Other accounts. Two other accounts have reposted the same clip. Both of them trace back to the original account. No independent copy, and no longer version.
6	A detection tool. An online AI detector returns "82% likely manipulated." It gives no method, no error rate and no explanation.
7	Context. The director has received threats in recent months. Sharing the clip further — even to deny it — puts it in front of people who have not seen it.
